It was time for rounds 7-8 of the Porsche Carrera Cup this time at the exciting Knockhill Racing Circuit.

Friday's free practice sessions went well with Lewis finishing P4 in FP1 and P6 in FP2 testing the limits of the challenging track ready to go into qualifying the following day.



Saturday was qualifying day with cloudy and dry conditions Lewis pushed to qualify P5 ready for race day on Sunday.

With the same conditions as qualifying it was time for race 1 with a great start from Lewis gaining 2 positions throughout the race to finish on the podium P3.



Race 2 was later on that day with all to play for starting P4.

Lewis got a good start to the race holding his position and eventually made a move on lap 3 making his way into the P3 position.

Lewis then had a queue of cars behind him giving him the task of defending P3 for the rest of the race.

Lap 5 saw Lewis set the fastest lap of the race so far and still continued to defend his P3 position.

On lap 6 a safety car was deployed due to a car going off track and an oil spill causing them to not resume racing until lap 13.

The racing eventually continued on with constant battles being thrown Lewis' way until again on lap 15 another safety car being out due to another car going off track.

The car was then cleared giving the green light to race again and the defending continued right until the end with the last few minutes of the race saw Lewis drop a place down to P4 to finish.

It was a successful weekend for team Valluga and gained us some good points putting us 5th in the entrant championship and Lewis 5th in the Pro category overall.



When speaking to Lewis he said, "Overall a solid weekend for us on points.

To get a podium finish in race 1 was a great result for the team.

I had a good start in race 2 and managed to get into 3rd before the safety car. Unfortunately I got held up from P2 and Cammish managed to get past us for 3rd.
